In order to encourage a younger audience to experience Japanese cinema, the Japan Foundation and the participating partner venues <u>in the regional area</u> * are calling for applications to join this new scheme. The selected Ambassador can access a screening of their choice with our invitation tickets.

- 1. Eligible applicants will fulfill these three requirements:
- Anybody between 18 years old and 30 years old, living in the UK and who will be able to access one of the touring venues <u>outside London</u> for the Japan Foundation Touring Film Programme 2023.

- Those who regularly use Social Networking Services such as Facebook, Twitter and Instagram and are willing to promote the Japan Foundation Touring Film Programme 2023, in particular for the screening that the applicant attended.
- Those who are willing to make a small report after attending the screening, by completing the short report form provided by the Japan Foundation.
- 2. Applicants should note the following:

Max 2 Young Ambassadors at each venue. One person can apply for multiple screenings if they wish.

- 3. These applicants will be prioritized:
- Those who have more than 1000 followers or friends on Twitter, Instagram and Facebook

OR/AND

Those who have not attended the Japan Foundation Touring Film Programme before.

4. <u>Deadline for application</u>

There is no specific deadline, but we encourage applicants to apply at least 3 weeks beforethe screening they wish to attend in order to secure their seat.
